

Entering 1st or 2nd Grade Suggested Reading

Summer reading is **required** for students entering grades 1 and grade 2 with prize incentives for students at the beginning of the 2024-2025 school year. Students **entering grade 1** are required to accumulate a minimum of **900 minutes**. Students entering **grade 2** are required to accumulate a minimum of **1,000 minutes**. Minutes read over the summer beginning June 1 and ending August 26, 2024, can be counted. Students will earn **a grade** for the completion of the required summer reading.

For your convenience, students can log their reading minutes on the calendar provided. Please total the minutes at the end of the summer and record in the link by Friday, August 30, 2024. https://forms.office.com/r/mTyukZbMTu. You do not need to return the paper calendar.
