

## Summer Semester Policies

This statement of policies and terms covers all Maranatha Christian Academy Summer Semester Camps and Classes. By registering, you agree to these Policies and Terms.

#### Registration

Registration for Summer Camps begins on February 27, 2024. Registration for Academic Tutoring opens April 15, 2024. No registrations will be accepted before this date. You can register online at <a href="https://www.mcamustangs.org/mymca/parents/summer-camp">https://www.mcamustangs.org/mymca/parents/summer-camp</a> mcamustangs.org/summer using our online registration system. There is a nonrefundable \$50 deposit per class that will be applied toward your Summer Day Camps tuition. A completed Maranatha Christian Academy Summer Semester Registration with emergency contact and medical information is required for each participant. Also, an authorization for administration of medication is needed, if applicable.

Students should register for classes according to **the grade they will attend in the fall**. A confirmation of your registration will be sent via email upon successful completion of the registration process. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

#### <u>Payment</u>

Payment for each activity is listed on the registration site, along with available payment plans if you choose. A \$25 fee will be assessed for insufficient funds or a declined credit card.

#### Refund Policy:

No refunds will be given after June 10, 2024. A refund minus the \$50 registration deposit will be given for registrations canceled a week prior to the start date of the course/camp. After June 10th, refunds minus the \$50 registration fee will be credited to your school tuition account if a weeks' prior notice is given.

A refund for medical reasons applies only to absences of one week or longer and requires a doctor's note.

#### Schedule Changes and Cancellations

All requests for camp schedule changes must be received in writing. Emails are accepted at dane.wellens@mcamustangs.org. We cannot guarantee that every change or cancellation will be accommodated and fees may apply.

#### Camp Changes and Cancellations

We reserve the right to combine camps or cancel any camps as necessary. In the event of a camp change, the dates are subject to change. In the event of a cancellation, we will do our best to notify families at least two weeks prior to the start of the class. We will also offer the option of receiving a refund.

#### <u>Absences</u>

Tuition will not be prorated or refunded due to bad weather, family vacations, or conflicting activities. If a student is asked to withdraw from an activity because of inappropriate conduct, a refund will not be issued. A refund for medical reasons may be considered for absences of two days or longer, and a doctor's note is required.

#### Lost or Stolen Items

Parents are requested to label all clothing with the student's name to ensure complete identification of all items and to protect against loss. Project Summer Day Camp assumes no responsibility for lost of stolen personal property. We discourage all participants from bringing anything of value, such as jewelry, electronics, money, or expensive clothing. Students should not bring toys, electronic units, trading cards, or other similar items.

#### <u>Appropriate Dress</u>

Students are required to dress appropriately for summer activities. We do not allow clothing that reveals underwear, excessive display of skin (i.e.: halter/crop tops, short-shorts, etc.), or clothing that advertises alcohol or other chemicals, weapons, or groups that condone chemical use. Students in violation of the summer dress code will be required to change into more appropriate clothing. Some field trips may require specific clothing.

#### <u>Instructor Changes</u>

We reserve the right to change the instructor of any class as staffing needs and schedules dictate. We make every effort to have instructors arranged by our catalog print date but changes do occur.

#### <u>Transfer of Students Between Age Groups</u>

Maranatha Christian Academy reserves the right to move participants between age groups as maturity indicates.

#### **Enrichment Club Discount Codes:**

Enrichment Courses are fee based clubs and activities that pull your child from the care and activities being provided to them by the base fee. Being that your child is not in that care for that allotment of time, we have created discount codes for each Enrichment Club to match what you have already paid for care for those hours.
